

## Investigation Committee Decision Summary

An Investigation Committee of the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Prince Edward Island recently issued orders under subsection 52(1) of the Regulated Health Professions Act to member Chloe Hassan, Registration Number 2501, with Ms. Hassan's consent.

The orders related to a complaint that Ms. Hassan failed, in the Psychiatric Intensive Care Unit at Hillsborough Hospital in Charlottetown, PEI, in late April and certain dates in May, 2022, to measure vital signs as ordered by the physician on a number of patients, failed to measure blood pressure as ordered by the physician before administering a medication, failed to follow proper discharge protocol during a patient discharge from hospital, and falsified patient records to document that things were done which had not been completed.

The complaint was investigated, and the Investigation Committee decided to refer the complaint to a hearing, while simultaneously providing an opportunity to Ms. Hassan to consent to certain orders. Ms. Hassan decided to consent, and no hearing was required.

The orders consented to by Ms. Hassan were as follows:

1. Chloe Hassan is ordered to complete courses in
  - (a) Medication Administration and
  - (b) Ethics related to the Nursing Profession which are acceptable to the Investigation Committee within 60 days of the date the Committee's decision was delivered to Ms. Hassan; and
2. Chloe Hassan shall pay a fine in the amount of \$2,500.00 to the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Prince Edward Island within 90 days of the date this decision is delivered to Ms. Hassan.

Upon completion of the requirements of these orders, the complaint process will be concluded.
